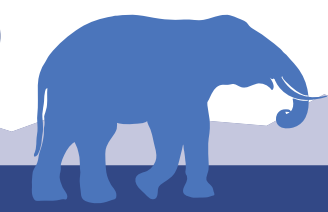




MOUNTAIN VIEW CORRIDOR

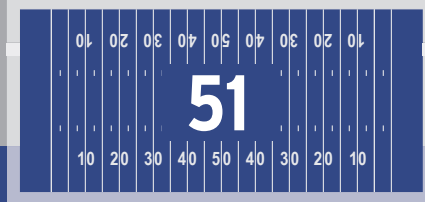

Project Phases

CURRENT PHASE

Two lanes built in each direction from Redwood Road (at approximately 16000 South) to 5400 South with land reserved in the middle to build a future freeway.

FUTURE PHASES

- Extend Mountain View from 5400 South to I-80 (8.5 miles)
- Extend Mountain View from 16000 South to Lehi Main Street (5.7 miles)
 - Intersections will be converted to freeway interchanges
 - Additional lanes will be added
 - Transit will be built
 - Trails will be extended

35-mile fully functional freeway from I-80 to Lehi Main Street.
